Here is what you need to do:

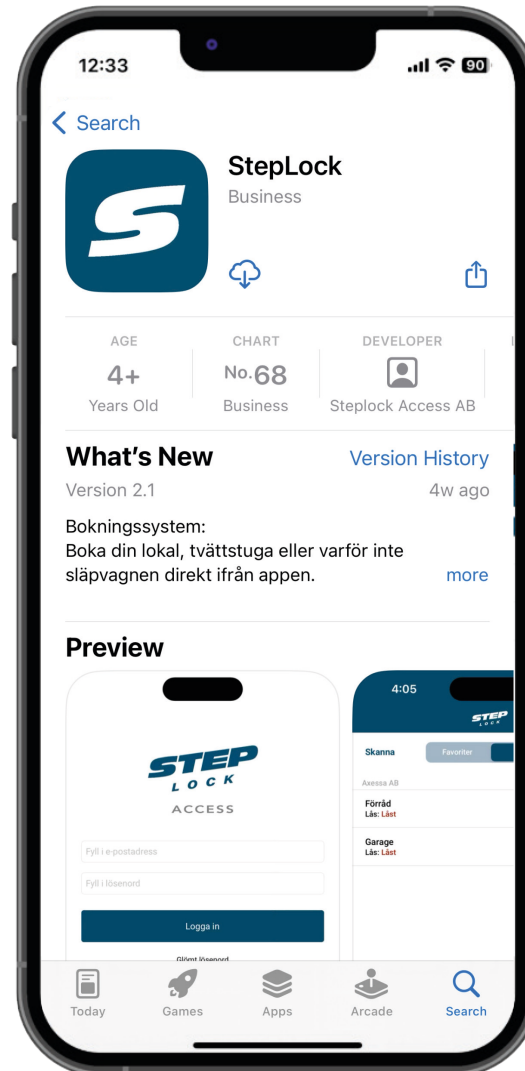
- Download the StepLock app from the App Store or Google Play.

Download the StepLock app from the App Store or Google Play.

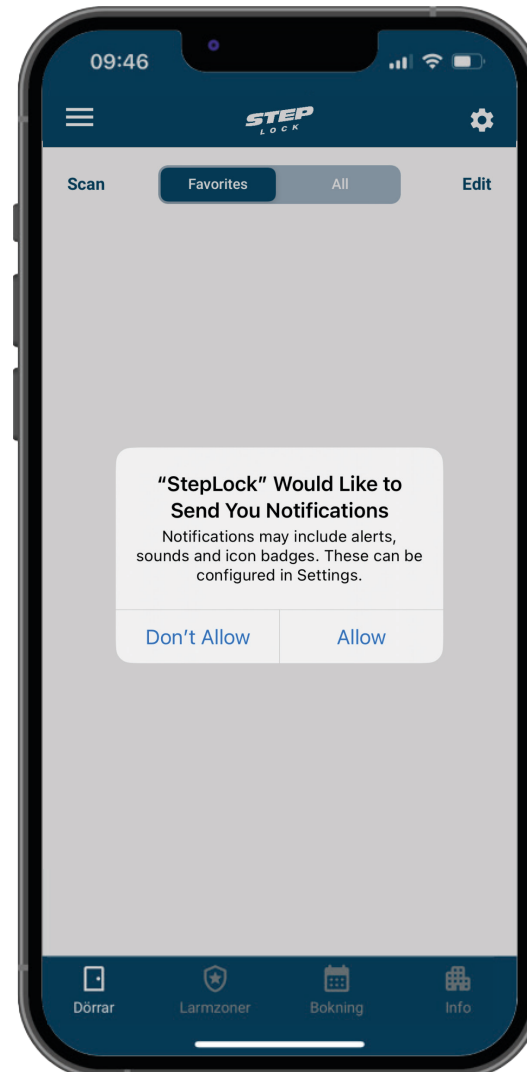




When it has to work.

Click "Allow" to grant the app the necessary permissions

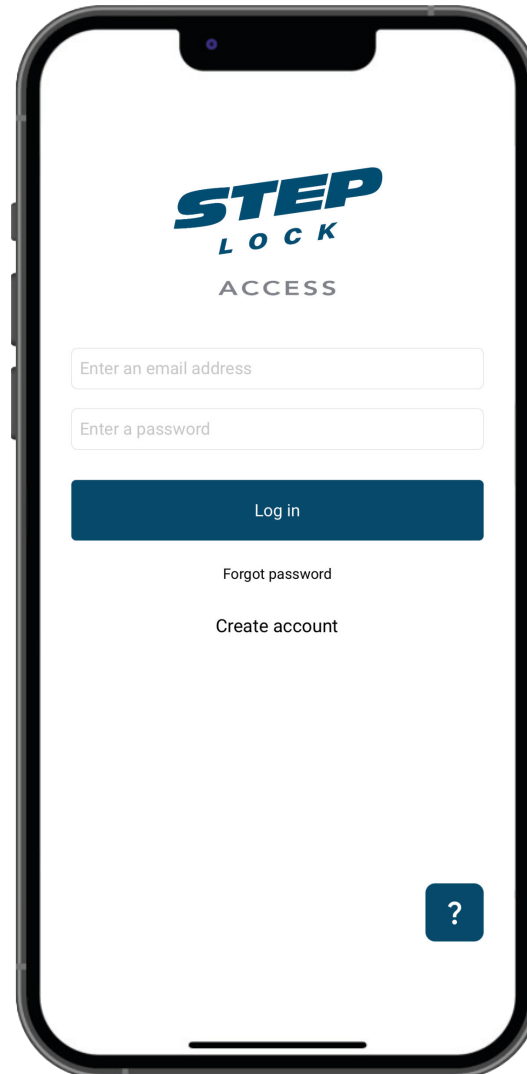
We do not collect, nor do we access video, audio, or image files on your device.

Click "Create account".



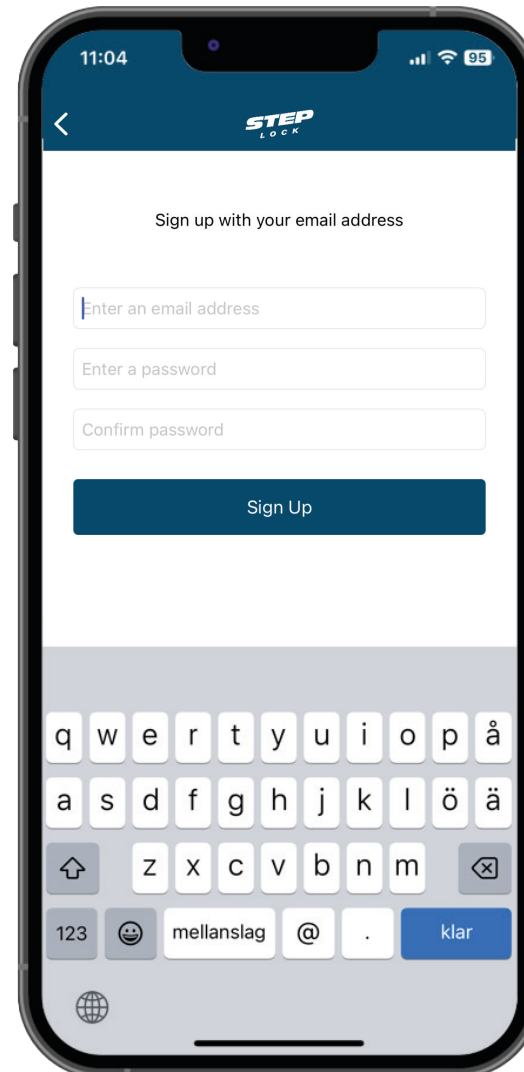


When it has to work.

Please note that your password is personal. Do not share it with anyone. We will never ask you for your password.

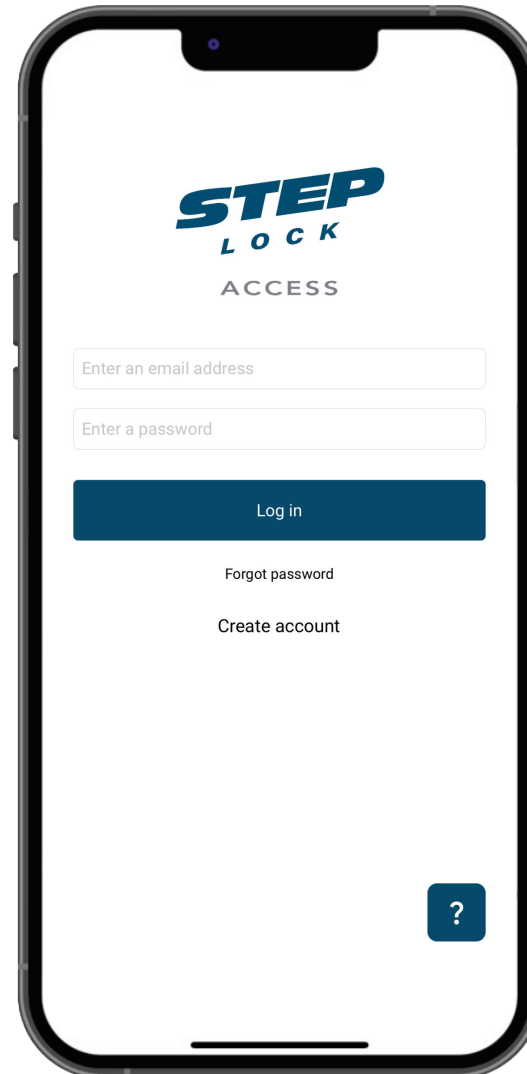




When it has to work.

and password.

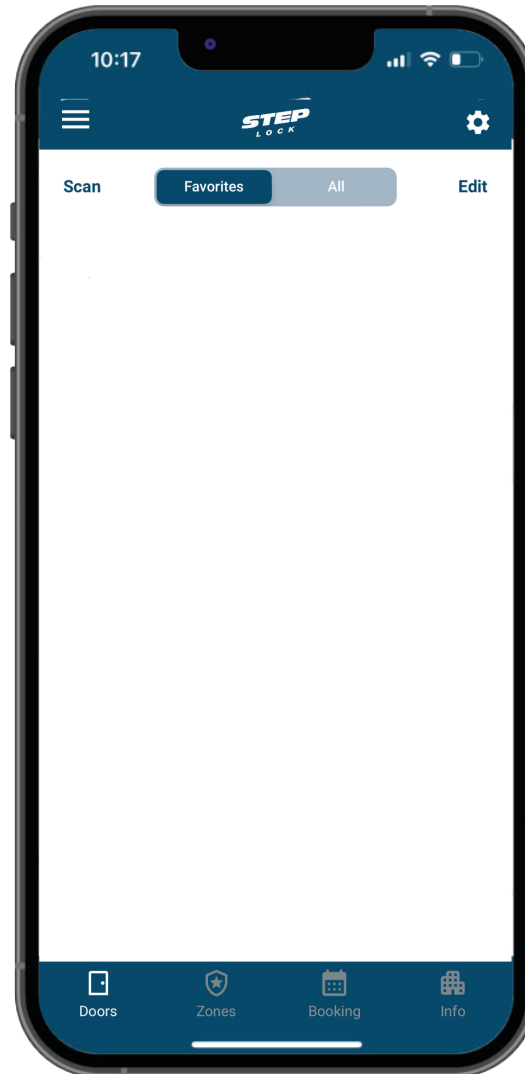
Then, press "Log In".





When it has to work.

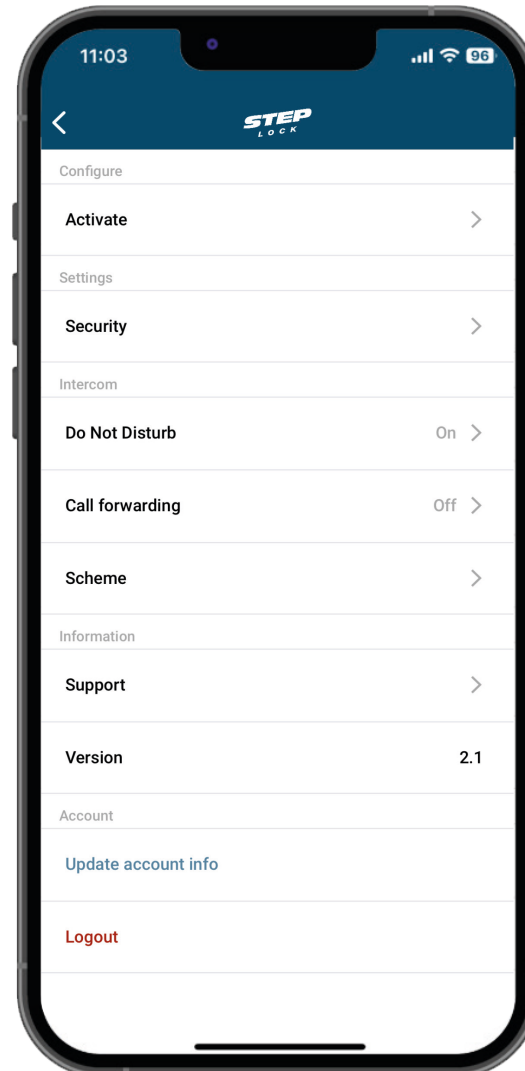
Click on the gear icon in the top right corner.

Click "Activate" at the top of the menu.



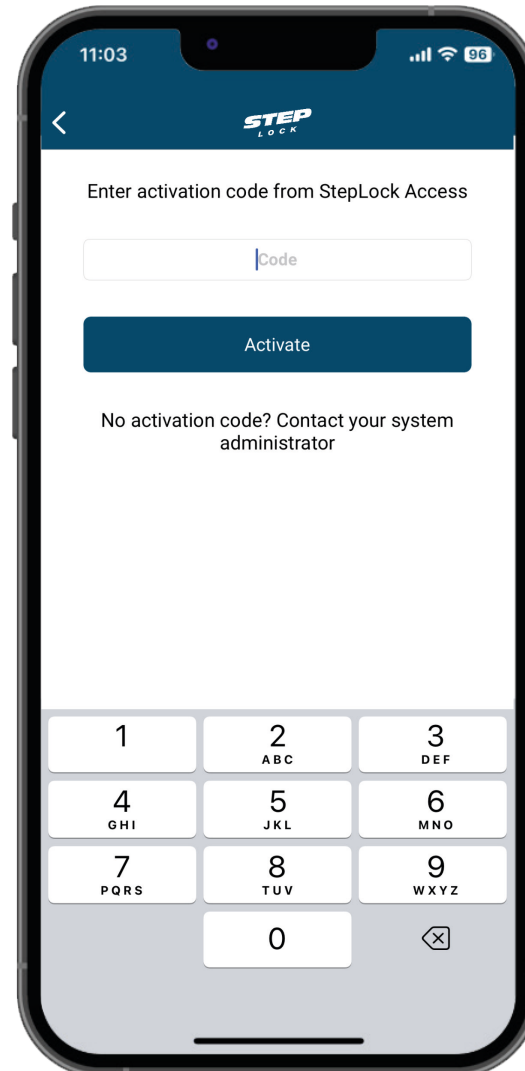


When it has to work.
